Objective of the whole course

This curriculum objective is to lead to positions of junior staff in the domain of exploitation, maintenance or studies in public transport networks. The intermodality issues are considered as an élément of général culture more than as the core of the future activities of the graduates. This explains the relatively low amount of hours dedicated to this question.

So, the students may :

- understand the complexity of the management of public transport chains,
- understand the means of conception of transport nodes
- have some notions of intermodal management (information of the customers, tariffing, etc.)

Content of the whole course

- General introduction (3 h)
- Legal framework (3 h)
- Organisational and management issues (3 h)
- Conception and realization of intermodality nodes (from an architectural point of view)(8 h)
(a site visit is included)
- Integrated tariffs linked to intermodality (3 h)
